







cotton

A soft, fluffy material that comes from the cotton plant. It's used to make things like clothes, towels and bedsheets.







denim

The material that jeans are made of.





A special substance used to change the colour of something, like fabric or hair.



harvest (harvested)

To collect plants, like fruits, vegetables, or grains, when they're ready to be eaten or sold. "Harvested" is when this has already been done.




eans

Instructions or paths that tell you how to go from one place to another.

explode

When something bursts or breaks apart very quickly and with a lot of force.

explosion

Things explode outwards, usually with noise, light and energy.

<u>divide</u>

The act of breaking something up into smaller pieces or groups.

division

A way of finding out how many times one number fits into another or how things can be shared equally.

educate To teach or to give knowledge and skills.

education

The process of receiving or giving systematic instruction, especially at a school or university.

<u>invent</u>

To create something completely new that has never been made before.

invention The thing that you create when you invent something.

persuade

To try to convince them to do something or to believe in something.

persuasion

The act or process of persuading someone.






A type of film or TV programme that tells you facts about real people, events or subjects.


programme

documentary


A film or programme about a real person or event.
